Air Quality Statement

CBSC provides athletic programming for CBSC members, most of which are held outdoors at CBSC club facilities or outdoors in the surrounding local Crescent Beach community. Many of the CBSC programs are high intensity, with potentially lengthy periods of exercise in an outdoor environment, and therefore air quality conditions are required to be assessed from time to time. This will help ensure that CBSC members will not be put at risk while participating in or viewing any high intensity outdoor CBSC program. CBSC holds the health, safety and wellbeing of all CBSC members and visitors as the highest priority.

Objectives:

 To assist CBSC staff, and Board of Directors to make appropriate decisions on when CBSC programming is impacted by air quality issues.

Procedure:

CBSC shall:

- In the event air quality becomes a cause for concern, CBSC Program Chairs will modify or cancel programming when the British Columbia Air Quality Health Index (BCAQHI) indicates that there is a moderate to very high health risk.
- CBSC will use the BCAQHI measurements available at the website https://gis.metrovancouver.org/maps/air/.
- Measurements at the North Delta, Tsawwassen and Surrey East stations will be utilized to determine the modification or cancellation of CBSC programming.
- Notice of a modification or cancellation of an activity will follow the process of modification/cancellation of programming communication policy to members.
